

# BCD Vendor Application

The **Toronto Triumph Club** invites you to participate in the **41th annual British Car Day®**, taking place on **Sunday, September 20th, 2026**, at Bronte Creek Provincial Park, Burloak Drive, Oakville.

## Details:

Vendor rates include admission (via the north maintenance gate off Burloak Dr.) for 1 vehicle, a trailer and/or tent and 2 people, plus reserved parking for your vehicle and/or trailer for the duration of the event (admission & set-up is **ON THE DAY OF EVENT ONLY**).

Spaces are located throughout the Vendor Village and will be allocated on a “first come, first served” basis, with priority given to vendors who attended last year and who submit their application early. The configuration of the Vendor Village is developed based on the blend of spaces reserved and is not always identical to previous years. Every effort is made to maintain the same space locations for returning vendors.

**Vendors must adhere to the site space that has been purchased.** This will be strictly enforced on show day. If you require a space that doesn't conform to the Vendor sites offered, please contact the Vendor Coordinator directly. Adjustments can be made in advance but must be discussed prior to June 15th.

## Application:

Please complete the Vendor Space Application and Waiver form below and submit with your payment, by **June 15th, 2026** to take advantage of the "Early Bird" prices. The “Early Bird “option is provided for three reasons.

1. It rewards vendors for confirming attendance and allows the volunteers to begin the vendor village layout.
2. The “Early Bird “vendor list can be included in the BCD show program.
3. The “Early Bird “vendor list can be used to print the individual location signs which are extremely beneficial during the early morning setup.

All applications (early Bird & Regular) must be received **NO LATER than July 31<sup>th</sup> 2026** to attend the show.

We will contact you by e-mail in early September and provide you with the parking permit which includes the vendor space location. Returning vendors will be assigned the identical space as 2024 unless a request was made for a different location.

**Fine Print:**

- Cancellation Policy:** If the vendor cancels **less than 4 weeks** prior to the show date, for any reason, this will result in the forfeit of the vendor fee and location.
- Advertising:** Large tents and/or signage must be secured safely and be able to accommodate all types of weather.
- Arrangement of exhibits:** All vendor materials must stay within the boundaries of their designated space and not impede on surrounding vendor spaces or public walkways.
- Set up:** Allowed on Sunday, September 20th only – any materials dropped off or set up prior to Sunday morning **will be removed** at the vendor’s expense.
- Noise and Machinery:** There is no power to the site and under no circumstances can generators be used to power any type of machinery within the rows of the Vendor Village. This is for the health & safety of the fellow vendors and patrons. Food vendors are exempt as they will be situated away from the Vendor Village, at various locations throughout the field.
- No subletting:** Under no circumstances can the signed vendor sublet their space to another vendor. This would result in the cancellation of the agreement and loss of vendor fee.
- Care:** It is the vendor’s responsibility to keep their site clean and allow clear and safe access for the public and to ensure Site is clean when leaving.

**WAIVER:** I agree to waive all claims against the Toronto Triumph Club and its Officers and Organizers for any injury, loss or damages incurred during my participation in **British Car Day® on September 20,2026**
